



This week in Maths, the focus has been on measure and how to record length in different forms i.e. 136cm, 1m 36cm and 1.36m. The children have also been learning in cm and half-cm, and have enjoyed practical lessons measuring things in the playground.

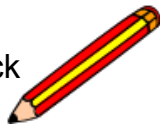
In Literacy, the focus has been on how to create Higher-Order Thinking (HOTS) questions. The children watched an animated video clip then came up with a number of different questions that would challenge the thinking of others by prompting a more in-depth answer. Some of the children demonstrated their learning through a hot-seating activity.

All classes have also been busy in groups creating Information Dodecahedrons that demonstrates some of their learning in our Scotland and India/Japan/Costa Rica comparison topic. These will be completed in time for next week's Open Evening, which we hope you can come along to between 5.30-7.00 p.m.
