



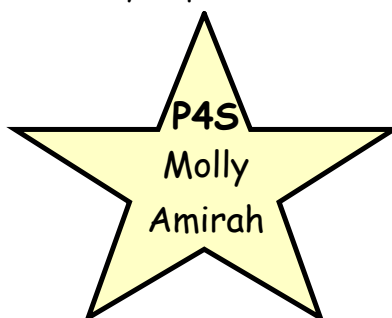
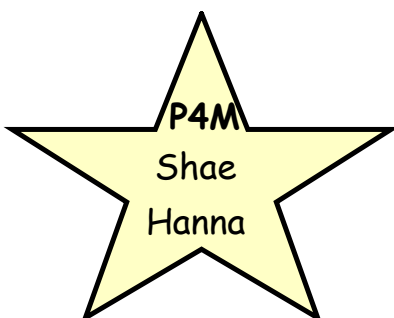
# Trinity Primary School

In Science this week, we investigated materials which dissolve and which do not dissolve by carrying out experiments.
